### **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FALL 2010**

All students entering Kindergarten in the fall must be registered at the Anthony Wayne Administrative Center (9565 Bucher Road in Whitehouse) by a parent or legal guardian prior to Kindergarten Screening in June. Registration is by appointment only. You may schedule an appointment by calling 419-877-5377. The registration process includes the completion of the Kindergarten Registration form as well as providing the required documents. It is not necessary for your child to accompany you to registration. Students entering Kindergarten in August of 2010 must be five (5) years old by September 30, 2010.

Click on the registration link and look for the downloadable Kindergarten Registration form on the right side of the webpage. Forms are also available in the school office kiosk, as well as the Administrative Center. Registration forms are not available by mail, and we will not accept faxed registration forms.

Please register your child at our Central Administrative Office prior to March 25<sup>th</sup> so that we can plan for Kindergarten Screening later in the spring.

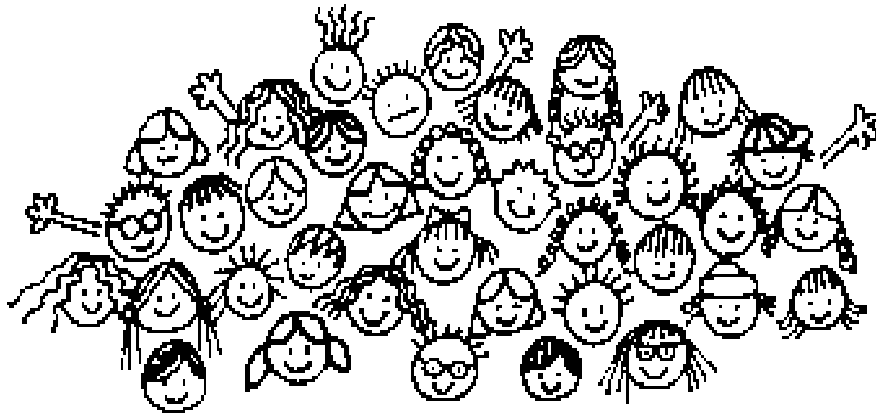

## Every Child Deserves a School Nurse

Charlotte Cowan, MD, is a pediatrician and children's author of "Sadie's Sore Throat". She tells the story of Sadie, the giraffe, who has a sore throat. She doesn't want to eat or drink because it hurts to swallow. Sadie's temperature is 102 and her stomach hurts. What parent hasn't been in this helpless situation with their child?

Most sore throats are from viral infections. Viral sore throats are usually accompanied by a "cold" (runny or stuffy nose, cough, and maybe a mild fever). These sore throats, caused by viruses, will go away on their own.

Sore throats can also be caused by a bacterium called *Streptococcus* (the infamous strep throat). This sore throat is painful. It doesn't go away with that glass of water. Your child may also have a stomachache and fever. The only way to confirm a strep infection is with a throat culture at the physician office. Antibiotics are needed to treat strep throat.

Most throat infections are contagious; unfortunately, most people are contagious before they actually have the symptoms of being sick. Remind your children to wash their hands, especially before they eat, and keep their hands away from their mouth, nose and eyes.

If your child has a persisting sore throat, contact your child's physician's office. If your child has strep throat, he should not return to school until he has taken antibiotics for 24 hours. If your child has a fever, he should not return to school until he is fever-free for 24 hours and has not taken fever-reducing medication (like Tylenol or Motrin) for 24 hours.
