Reading/Language Arts:

Reading skills we have learned the last few weeks include:

Generalizing, Drawing Conclusions, and identifying the Theme. Our skill for this week is Text Structure. The students will read a nonfiction selection about Lou Gehrig. The story is set up in chronological order, which will lead us into timelines.

Mrs. Seeger and Mrs. Dick's classes will also be studying types of poetry and elements of poetry, such as similes, metaphors, and idioms.

In Language, our focus has been adjectives.

MATH with Mrs. Dick

We have started division! The students have been spending 10 minutes daily reviewing their flashcards and taking a 100 problem, 7 minute timed test. Just like long multiplication, your child has learned 2 methods of long division. The team has done a great job, and is already dividing with remainders. We will have a 2 digit divided by a 1 digit quiz this week and begin dividing 3 digit numbers later in the week. Additionally, your child should always be checking their division by multiplying.

Science with Mrs. Seeger

We are finishing up our unit on chemical and physical changes this week with a test on Friday. The students have learned what qualifies as a physical change (cutting, melting, freezing, etc.) and what qualifies as a chemical change (heating, dissolving, changing to a new substance, etc.) We will be spending the next two weeks on measurement along with some of Mrs. Dick's math classes. Here, we will focus on both standard and metric measurements. I am again in need of baby wipes and paper towels. Any donation is very much appreciated!

Social Studies with Mrs. Birt

The students will finish their study of historic Native Americans with our test tomorrow. We will then begin Unit 2: The Ohio Territory. The students will also begin their Famous Ohioans project. More information will come home on Friday, January 22nd.
